



An Invitation from CervicalCheck is One to Accept

CervicalCheck – The National Cervical Screening Programme encourages every woman to go for her free smear test when she receives an invitation.

About a smear test

A smear test is a simple procedure that only takes minutes, and is the most effective way to detect changes in the cells of the cervix. CervicalCheck has a list of eligible women aged 25 to 60. Over the next three years every woman on the list will receive a letter of invitation from CervicalCheck for a free smear test.

How to arrange your free smear test

With an invitation you can have a free smear test with any smearer (GP or practice nurse) registered with CervicalCheck. Thousands of GPs, Women's Health, Family Planning and Well Woman Clinics all over Ireland are registered.

If you have already had a CervicalCheck smear test, CervicalCheck will let you know when your next smear test is due.

If you have not had a smear test in the last three years

If you have not had a smear test in the last three years and have not yet received an invitation, you can simply register online at www.cervicalcheck.ie or complete and return a form by Freepost or call CervicalCheck on Freephone 1800 45 45 55. CervicalCheck will then send you an invitation letter by post.
