Thank you for attending HPV cervical screening on [testdate].

Your sample was tested for the human papillomavirus (HPV). Your results show that **HPV was not found**. Because HPV was not found, we did not check for changes to the cells in your cervix (neck of the womb).

As the HPV virus was not found in your sample, your risk of developing cervical cancer is very low.

This result means you will be invited for your next HPV cervical screening in 5 years. However, you should always pay attention to possible symptoms such as irregular vaginal bleeding, pelvic pain, spotting or unusual discharge. You should go to your doctor if you have any symptoms.

Your doctor or nurse who did your test has received a copy of the results.
