Thank you for attending your recent HPV cervical screening on [testdate]. Your sample was tested for the human papillomavirus (HPV).

Because **HPV was found**, we also checked for changes to the cells in your cervix (neck of the womb) and **no abnormal cell changes were seen**.

In order to monitor this, you will be invited for a repeat test in 12 months. This will give your body time to clear the HPV infection.

Your doctor has also received a copy of your result.

You can read more about what your results mean in the leaflet, 'Important information about your HPV cervical screening results'. Your result is listed under result – HPV found and no abnormal cell changes found.

You can read more about your results and about the benefits and limitations of screening of HPV cervical screening in the leaflet we sent you previously or on [hse.ie/cervicalcheck](http://hse.ie/cervicalcheck).

Cervical cancer is a rare outcome of HPV infection. However, you should always pay attention to possible symptoms such as irregular vaginal bleeding, pelvic pain, spotting or unusual discharge and go to your doctor if you have any symptoms.

We will send you a letter when it's time for your next cervical screening test in 12 months.
